PROCEEDINGS OF THE RESEARCH & EXTENSION INTERFACE MEETING FOR THE MONTH OF JULYON DT. 18.07.2017OF KRISHI VIGYAN KENDRA, DEOGARH

The research & extension interface meeting for the month of July, 2017was held at 4.00 PM on dt.18.07.2017 in the Chamber of Senior Scientist & Head, KVK, Deogarh under the Chairmanship of Sri Bijaya Kumar Mohapatra, Deputy Director Agriculture-cum-PD ATMA, Deogarh.

After a brief introductory remark about the meeting of research and extension interface by Senior Scientist & Head, KVK the following discussions have been made department wise as per the instruction of the Chairman.

1) Department of Agriculture

Rainfall received during the month as on dt.17/7/17 is 216.4mm against normal rainfall 245.5 mm which is 12% less.Crop coverage under paddy 23899 ha against 34500 ha. Transplanting area covered 1265 ha against target of 11547 ha. Beusaningof paddy 5860 ha against target 22634 ha. Non-paddy coverage is 18730 ha against the target 32450 ha. Total no. of soil sample collected 3840 against target 5050 & sample tested is 202 nos.NFSM (rice) - 1100 ha under line transplanting, DSR (300 ha) and stress tolerance (300 ha).NFSM(pulse) –Mini kit Greengram (var.-IPM-2-14) - 250 kits, Blackgram(var - IPU-2-43) -150 kits, NMOOP (oilseed)-minikit -Sesame(var-RT-346) of 200 kits. Under state plan green manuring cum seed production programme 100 ha (25 q) of Dhanicha seed, line transplanting of paddy 400 ha, 21 nos. of seed treatment campaign on paddy @ 7 nos. per block already started w.e.f 17.07.17.In RKVY plan E-pest surveillance of kharif 2017 started. 18 farmers trained and employed for Kharif & Rabi season. In ITDAprogramme hybrid maize of 46.5 ha area in weeding and top dressing stage. In ATMA programme Sweet corn var. Indam-003 0.32 kg has been supplied to each block(Total 0.96 kg), each unit 0.25 of acre. Total area covered is 64 ha. Farm school will also be organised 1 no. in each block. Under PMFBY programme 531 nos. of non loans farmers and 11072 nos. of loanee farmersenrolled.

2) Department of Horticulture

Assistant Horticulture Officer, Deogarh has been summarised that department started diversion of QPM for40 hamango plantation under NHM, 75 ha mango plantation in convergence with MGNREGA and NHM, 75 ha mango plantation purely under MGNREGA. 50 ha cashew plantationstarted inconvergence with MGNREGA, input subsidy of Mango distributed to Reamal block beneficiaries in State plan.In ITDA programme Kharif tomato programme has been started in KalchipadaDihi and Beluam villages of Sodo gram panchayat.

3) Veterinary Department

Veterinary Department, Deogarh completed the following programmes in the month of July, 2017.

- i) Vaccination of Livestock-35350 nos.
- ii) Backyard poultry chick of 45 nos. supplied to each of the 24 BPL farmers.
- iii) Artificial Insemination of 995 cattle.
- iv) Insurance of animals under Risk Management -1152 nos.

4) Fishery Department

DistrictFisheries Officer briefing the achievement and action plan of fishery department.

Achievement of July 2017

- Own source development tank of an Area of 3.65 ha. visited by subsidy committee membersDeputy Director Fishery (AngulZone), Angul, DFO, Deogarh & AFO Block concerned.
- 2. 108.00 lakhs of spawn (fish seed) stocked in Govt. fish farm Barkote for fry production.
- 3. Supervision of 27 nos. WSHG involved in fisheries activities in the district.
- 4. 20 nos. of net & boat proposal sponsored to Banks under MUY scheme.
- 5. Supervision of ongoing project under RKVY & Blue revolution was made.

Proposed Action Plan for August 2017

- 1. Subsidy under Bank finance & own source developed tanks of area 5.18 ha. will be released during the month.
- 2. Fry (fish seed) distribution to be started and to be supplied to farmers.

Soil Conservation Department

Turfing of 22 projects started during this month. Training for primary stake holder, 2 nos. will be started from dt.28.07.2017

NGO, CSDR, Madhyapur

Under IRRI programme 50 ha demonstration will be taken up in Reamal Block. Head to head trial of 2 hawill also be taken up during this kharif.

Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Deogarh

Senior Scientist & Headproposed the action plan of KVK Deogarh for the year 2017-18as 4 nos. of OFT,11 nos. of FLD, 36 nos. of farmers and farm women training, 6 nos. in-service training, 3 nos. of rural youth training and 3 nos. of Vocational training to be conducted under Horticulture, Plant Protection and Soil Science discipline. Doubling Farmers' Income by Technological Interventions of KVK has also placed in the meeting andthe proposed action plan and module has been approved by the members. In cluster demonstration of pulses (Pigeonpea) sowing is completed in total 20 ha area in villages like Malehipada, Majhipalli and

Bangalimunda. Training programme for the month of July 2017of horticulture, plant protection and soil science discipline will be conducted from 22th, 25th and 26th of this month. Action plan for the month of August 2017 proposed as 3 nos. farmers and farm women training of Horticulture, Plant Protection and Soil Science discipline, 3 nos. of Extension Functionaries training of Horticulture, Plant Protection and Soil Science discipline will be conducted, 20 ha. area of cluster demonstration on oil seed (sesame), OFT and FLD programmes will be conducted during this August.

The Chairman thanked all the members & urged cooperation from all line departments for benefit of farming community of the district.
